In 1997, the first AutoCAD 2000 software was released. After several years of development, the company released AutoCAD LT in 2002. AutoCAD LT was intended to be used by less-skilled designers. A number of later-released versions of AutoCAD LT included more advanced features. In 2017, Autodesk announced that the company was discontinuing AutoCAD LT, AutoCAD Classic, and AutoCAD 2018. As of November 2017, Autodesk released version 2019, and introduced 2020. History AutoCAD was created by Steve Jobs and Bill Atkinson at the Apple Computer company in 1982.
